The stage, positioned in the southern part of the theatre, covered the open area of the horseshoe-shaped seating arrangement. It provided a platform for actors, musicians, and performers to showcase their talents. The stage was adorned with intricate decorations and architectural elements, reflecting the artistic sensibilities of the time.
