Discovering the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus

1. A Monument of Grandeur

The Mausoleum of Halicarnassus stood as a testament to the grandeur and ambition of Mausollos, a Carian Satrap who ruled for 24 years. In his desire for everlasting power and remembrance, Mausollos initiated the construction of the mausoleum in 355 BC. The monument soared approximately 50 meters high and was surrounded by a large elevated temenos, creating a majestic presence in the ancient city center.

2. Architectural Marvels

The mausoleum comprised four main sections, each showcasing the remarkable skills of the period's most renowned architects and sculptors. These sections included:

- **High Podium:** The mausoleum's base featured a high podium that elevated the structure, adding to its commanding presence. The podium served as the foundation for the rest of the monument.

- **Quadriga and Statues:** Crowned at the top of the mausoleum was a quadriga, a four-horse chariot, with Mausollos and his wife Artemisia depicted in regal poses. The statues immortalized the powerful couple and added a touch of divine symbolism to the monument.
