## By Air

The nearest airport to Gumbet is **Bodrum Milas Airport** (BJV), which offers domestic and international flights. Bodrum Airport is located 36 km. from central Bodrum and 39 km. from Gumbet.

There are variety of transportation opportunities to access Gumbet and Bodrum from Bodrum Milas Airport. HAVAS Official Airport Shuttle, minibuses, airport transfer companies, car hire and taxis are the most popular options.

Transfer from Bodrum Airport to Gumbet usually takes about 40 mins via private transfer, taxis or coach transfer. ### **Domestic Flights**

There are lots of direct domestic flights to Milas Bodrum Airport from many big cities in Turkey. From Istanbul you can fly via Turkish Airlines (www.thy.com) and Pegasus Airlines (www.flypgs.com).

### **International Flights**

There are also lots of direct international charter flights and cheap flights from numerous European cities and UK to the Milas Bodrum Airport. Other international flights are mostly being made through Istanbul and Izmir.

Here's how you can get to Gumbet from the airport:

### **1. Private Airport Transfer**

## By Sea

There are regular two ways ferryboat services to the Greek islands of Cos and Rhodes. Bodrum & Gumbet also connected to Knidos, Didim & Dalyan with boat service that are all departure from Bodrum harbour. # By Road

There are many bus companies operating between many major Turkish cities and Bodrum. It takes about 12 hours from Istanbul, 4 hours from Izmir and 10 hours from Ankara.

Gumbet is located 3 km. from central Bodrum and there are 24 hrs. regular dolmus (minibus) services from between Bodrum and Gumbet. Bodrum Bus Terminal is located in central Bodrum. (**Bodrum Bus Terminal:** +90 252 316 26 37)
