It is also significant to mark that by utilizing this building, Turkey Hill is contributing to its preservation in the county.

What Can You Do at Turkey Hill Experience?

When you arrive at Turkey Hill Experience, you're greeted by a fun gift store and a desk to check in or buy tickets. It's a good idea to buy tickets online in advance. This helps you pick your lab times and plan your visit better.

You can visit without buying the extra taste labs, but there's a general admission charge and an additional fee for the Taste Lab and Tea Discovery. These labs happen at specific times and have limited space. You can also just shop at the store without going to the actual Experience.

Once you're checked in, you can explore the Turkey Hill Experience until your lab time. You can also return to the exhibits after your lab session. Head upstairs to find fun displays and exhibits. You get a map when you arrive, so use it to make sure you don't miss anything. There are hands-on exhibits, and you can learn about Turkey Hill's history and their iced teas and lemonades. You can even try cow milking or sit in an old-fashioned milk truck. There's a mini ball pit for kids under six and a twirling slide.

Inside the lab, you start by washing your hands. Then you sit at long counters on stools. The lab technician walks you through creating your own ice cream flavor with swirls and mix-ins. You start with a vanilla base and can add a variety of flavors. It's not just about dumping flavors into an ice cream cup; you're learning to be mixologists. Choose mix-ins that work well together, not just everything.

Tips for a Smooth Lab Session:

- Be aware of the tall stools when booking, especially if you have back problems.
- The lab is wheelchair accessible and provides step pedals for the sinks.
- Photography is welcome, but audio and video recording are not allowed.
- Young children (under 3) may struggle to sit still for the 35-minute session.
- The generous ice cream portion might call for a light lunch before or after. Leftovers are welcome!
- Due to allergy concerns, the lab is not allergy-friendly.
- You can't keep the cool red tasting spatula, but the gift shop offers them for purchase. Plastic spoons are available for taking your ice cream creation on the go.
