The climate in Turkey is diverse and variations in seasons impact the enjoyment of its many attractive places for the visitors.

Spring (March to May):

Many people decide to visit Turkey in the spring season, as the season is a delightful time especially taking interest in exploring historical sites available in the country. During the spring season, tourists enjoy the weather as pleasantly mild. In this season, the temperature usually ranges between 15°C and 25°C (59°F to 77°F). The city Istanbul has blooming gardens and streets are less crowded with transports, which invites people from all over the world.

The famous tulip festival is usually decorated every month of April, which adds vibrant colors to the parks in its cities. Travelers experience a breathtaking landscape along with lush greenery of cities like Konya and Cappadocia. These cities are present in central Anatolia, Turkey and have moderate temperatures. Summer (June to August):

Autumn (September to November):

Travelers consider Autumn as an excellent season to visit Turkey. In this cool season, the temperature of the country ranges from 20°C to 30°C (68°F to 86°F). In this season, the Black Sea coast and the northern parts of Anatolia demonstrate awesome, cooler and attractive landscapes. In Autumn season, nearby restaurants and markets offer pumpkin soup, roasted chestnuts, grapes, apples, pomegranates and walnuts to the visitors.

Winter (December to February):

Winter in Turkey presents a quieter and more calm atmosphere for the tourists and local peasants. The inland and coastal areas of Antalya which are present in Cappadocia and Eastern Anatolia are covered with snowfall due to temperature of 10°C to 15°C (50°F to 59°F).

Many travelers love skiing, snowboarding and ice skating, and visit resorts in Uludağ or Palandöken. As winter weather in Turkey is quite chilly and rainy, therefore the season is considered to be off-peak for tourism and people who prefer warm climate over colder. This is the reason that Istanbul is less crowded and offers less noisy and peaceful cultural sites. People select the right time to visit Turkey according to their interests and experiences such as some people like to explore ancient ruins. Some people enjoy beach holidays only. And other people are interested in experiencing cultural festivals held in Istanbul and Anatolia.

Cities and places to visit in Turkey:

Istanbul

Cappadocia

The amazing views include rocky valleys, their unique shapes and color of rocks are red, pink and white. Pamukkale

Travelers usually visit Pamukkale to see beautiful white terraces. These white terraces are the rocks that are light colored and formed in hot springs. People come and visit the Library of Celsus which is an ancient grand building, inside the building there are well preserved scrolls and manuscripts related to history and literature. The building also serves as a tomb of a Roman senator whose name was Tiberius Julius Celsus. He was the senator who funded the construction of the building. The building is famous as it was once a trading hub where Roman people performed exchange of goods such as textiles, spices, oils and precious metals. Basically, Ephesus had served as a trade route for merchants and traders. People also praise visiting other famous historical sites such as the Great Theatre and Temple of Artemis which was once a religious symbol for Romans.

Antalya,

Antalya is an amazing city and well known for its beautiful beaches and old town of Kaleiçi. Tourists experience a blend of historical attractions of ancient Roman Hadrian's Gate. It is a well preserved tomb of Emperor Hadrian. The gate is beautifully designed with decorative marbles. These marbles have been collected from Mount Pentelicus in Greece which are known as Pentelic marble. Tourists also see the art work of carvings of deities like Nike, who was believed to be the goddess of victory by Romans.

Bodrum

The castle consists of houses of the Museum of Underwater Archaeology. The museum of Bodrum showcases artifacts from ancient shipwrecks.
