The food is fantastic, and it's free of cost. You can enjoy Turkish and other dishes here.

So, if you're flying from another airport, you might be able to use a different lounge because Turkish Airlines works with other airlines.

Easy, Check-in and More Bags.

Customer in Business Class are privileged in a certain way. This is so because there is a special check-in area that is reserved exclusively for your arrival, so you don't have to endure hours standing in endless lines at the airport. This means less waiting and more time in which one can feel free to do nothing or do things which do not necessarily have to be done all the time. The general policy of the Business Class flight is that the passenger is allowed to carry more baggage.

One more advantage: passengers are allowed two pieces of luggage each size must not exceed 32 kg, while in Economy, this size is limited to 23 kg. You can also take two personal items on board and one piece that has to be stowed in the overhead locker. Also, your bags are likely to be the first one's coming out of the baggage carousel.

Baggage Allowance in Turkish Airlines Business Class

Business class means more luggage. You can check two bags up to 32kg each, instead of one at 23kg.

Take two carry-on bags up to 55x40x23 cm and 8kg each, plus a small bag.

Get your bags fast with the priority tag.

Turkish Airlines Business Class Seats

Turkish Airlines business class seats promise comfort and style. Each seat includes helpful extras like built-in massages, personal reading lights, power outlets, and privacy screens.

On long flights, business class seats change into flat beds with armrests. You'll find a handy, adjustable table for work or relaxation, plus a smaller table for drinks. Every seat has a big screen with touch controls.

1. **Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner:** The Boeing 787-9 business class has a 1-2-1 seat setup. This means plenty of legroom and easy access to the aisle for every passenger. Turkish Airlines uses these planes often for flights between Turkey and the United States, especially from busy airports like New York, San Francisco, and Los Angeles.
2. **Boeing 777-300ER:** Turkish Airlines likes the Boeing 777-300ER. Its business class seats follow a 2-3-2 layout, so not everyone gets an aisle seat. This plane also flies between Istanbul and major U.S. cities like those mentioned above, plus Miami, Houston, and Chicago.
3. **Airbus A350-900:** The A350-900 has modern business class seats. You can change the seat position with a simple click. It also has private storage spaces with locks. The seats follow a staggered 1-2-1 layout, so everyone has their own space. This plane flies from Istanbul to cities like London, Dubai, Seoul, and Los Angeles.
4. **Boeing 737-900ER:** This newer Boeing 737 has a few rows of reclining business class seats at the front. It mainly flies from Istanbul to other places in Europe and the Middle East.
5. **Airbus A320-200:** This smaller plane has short flights. Its business class has only two seats per row. It includes modern features like charging ports, large screens, and touch controls. This Airbus mainly flies within Turkey and to nearby countries.
6. **Boeing 737 MAX 9:** This is a new plane with more space, big luggage areas, and the latest technology. Business class seats follow a three-seat layout, so there are middle seats.

Remember, Not all long flights offer the same kind of business class seat. Aircraft types matter. The Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner is a great choice. It has a 1-2-1 seat layout, so everyone gets an aisle seat. This newer plane has the latest features. The older Boeing 777-300 has a less desirable 2-3-2 layout and older amenities.

Booking Your Business Class Ticket

The cost of a Turkish Airlines business class ticket varies based on the route, travel dates, and booking time. Expect to pay several thousand dollars for a roundtrip flight between the U.S. and Turkey. However, it's possible to find deals.

You can increase your chances of upgrading to business class by joining the Miles & Smiles program. This loyalty program lets you earn points for free upgrades, extra baggage, and lounge access. You can also pay a fee to upgrade at the airport or before your flight, if seats are available.

How Much Does a Turkish Airlines Business Class Ticket Cost?

The price you pay for a Turkish Airlines business class ticket changes based on a few things. Where you're going, how popular the flight is, what time of year it is, and when you book your ticket all affect the cost. For example, a round trip ticket from Los Angeles to Istanbul can easily hit \$4,000 or more. But don't worry, we've found tickets for this same flight as low as \$2,500.

Paying for a Turkish Airlines Business Class Upgrade

You might be able to pay for a business class upgrade if there's an empty seat when you check in or if you call the airline before your flight. Keep in mind, this only works if there's an available seat.

If you're a Miles & Smiles member, you can use your saved miles for an upgrade. If you don't have enough miles, you'll need to pay extra. The price depends on the flight, but expect to pay between \$1,000 and \$2,000 for a one-way upgrade on a long flight across the Atlantic. This is still usually cheaper than buying a business class ticket from the start.

How Many Miles Do You Need for a Turkish Airlines Business Class Upgrade?

The number of miles you need to use for a business class upgrade depends on where you're going. A flight from North America to Turkey needs 45,000 miles, but a flight from Europe to Turkey only needs about 15,000 miles.
